



CHARTER GUIDE

THE CONTRACT

Moravia Yachting was established in Monaco in 1962 and attains the highest industry standards. Our charter contracts are scrutinised to detail the rights of both yacht owner and guest, including payment, insurance and cancellation. Common terms of contract used are MYBA (Worldwide Yachting Association), CTI (Caribbean Terms Inclusive), American Yacht Charter Association (AYCA), Standard Eastern Mediterranean Terms (SEMT) and Greek Terms (GT). Moravia's brokers remain on hand to explain any terms of your contract.

MYBA

In general, Moravia applies the standard MYBA contract. The document requires that your chosen yacht will be chartered in working condition with all necessary equipment on board. This includes a competent crew and qualifies that marine insurance is in place, paid for by the vessel's owner. The charter fee and all other expenses, including fuel, port fees, food and beverages, are paid by the charterer. A handful of yachts do not meet United States fiscal standards so are not permitted to charter in American waters.

Charter rates

Charter rates are quoted by the week. On signature of a MYBA contract, a deposit of 50% is usually requested. The remainder, plus an Advance Provisioning Allowance (APA), is expected before embarkation. Base charter rates can fluctuate between destinations and high/low seasons, with rates typically higher at peak times and lower during the offseason. Fees are subject to rise during one-off events, such as the Cannes Film Festival and the Monaco Grand Prix. Planning your voyage ahead with a Moravia broker is key to securing your desired yacht at the best price.

Advance provisioning allowance (APA)

Under MYBA terms, the APA is normally between 30% and 40% of the total charter fee, depending on fuel consumption and proposed itinerary. (APA is used to pay for goods and services at cost price). This sum covers additional expenses such as fuel, food and beverages, port fees and other incidental costs. Moravia strives for transparency and itemised accounts will be provided to the guest before disembarkation. Any remaining credit can be transferred back to the charterer's account. Naturally, if expenditure exceeds the APA during the charter, additional funds will be requested.

Fuel

Every Moravia chartered yacht is fully fuelled and provisioned before a guest steps on board. The total fuel cost will depend on cruising speed and distance travelled, plus any fuel used by toys and tenders. The use of generators to produce electricity while in port or at anchor will also consume fuel.

Carbon offset

Guests who wish to offset their carbon emissions can do so using our trusted partner at a maximum cost of \in 200 per 10,000 litres of fuel consumed, and this fee can be transferred as part of the APA. At the end of each voyage the captain will measure fuel usage and any unused offset provision will be refunded to the charterer. Our brokers can advise on further actions you might like to take or can specify to the Captain, to minimise your environmental impact.

VAT

Value Added Tax (VAT) may be applied to the charter fee in some European and Caribbean destinations. The VAT rate varies from country to country, while specific itineraries allow for greater reductions. Moravia brokers are familiar with every VAT nuance and can give clear figures of prevailing rates in each destination.

Insurance

Moravia recommends charterers to take out cancellation and curtailment insurance. This will protect their booking should unforeseen circumstances prevent or postpone their voyage. All guests should be covered by a travel policy that includes personal accident and medical insurance, and personal items should be insured against loss, theft or damage. Moravia brokers can advise you further.

CHARTER ETIQUETTE

Make it yours

Every Moravia charter should guarantee a lifetime of memories. The better you can detail your aspirations and requirements, the better our brokers can fulfil your yachting ambition. Advance planning will assist us in contracting specialist crew members, such as guest speakers and wildlife guides, as well as enable us to source your favourite movies, beverages and treats. With prior notice your private staff can also be accommodated onboard.

Meet your crew

The crew will meet you on arrival, welcoming your party aboard and assisting you with any queries as you settle in. These yachting professionals frequently boast qualifications in engineering, navigation, watersports intructors and wellness. Friendliness, professionalism and sensitivity come as standard. Moreover, their skills in operating a high-value superyacht are second-to-none.

Indulge in dining

Foodies may enjoy ruminating each dish with the chef, while other guests will prefer to leave dining choices entirely to the professionals. Whatever your requirements, let the crew know your preferences as far in advance as possible so they can plan and delight as appropriate. And if a restaurant on shore tempts, kindly advise your captain that you won't be dining on board that evening. This saves food waste and prevents unnecessary items being added to your bill.

Ask your captain

Captains are a fountain of knowledge gleaned from decades of service across the globe. They are also required to manage a large team of people and are responsible for ensuring your overall charter experience is as desired. If you feel a crew member has not fulfilled a task correctly or their actions have caused you displeasure, kindly inform your captain as soon as possible. Moravia's charter team is also on-hand 24/7.

Invite your friends

This is your voyage. If you have friends on another yacht or associates in port, feel free to invite them aboard. Simply consult the captain beforehand to make sure maritime guidelines for hosting additional guests at anchor or in port are met.

Respect crew areas

The kitchen, crew mess and staff quarters remain off-limits to guests, ensuring that crew get the rest they require to safely operate the vessel and provide you with exceptional service. Most chefs stock a help-yourself counter beside their galley, where delicious hot and cold snacks are laid out at all hours.

Stay safe

Every superyacht captain is obliged to deliver a safety briefing. While it's unlikely that anything could occur on a world-class vessel, maritime law requests that guests are informed of lifejacket locations and the lifeboat drill. Smoking is prohibited aboard most yachts, although some vessels are able to prepare a smoking area with advance notice.

Barefoot bliss

Padding around your luxury yacht barefoot is a carefree pleasure, but removing one's shoes is a must. Most Moravia charter yachts are decked with teak, which can be damaged by heeled shoes, and a yacht's sumptuous carpets are often hand-made, making them sensitive to stains. A shoebox beside the passerelle will invite you to deposit outdoor footwear and a selection of slippers will be offered should you want them.

Luggage

Hard-shell luggage with wheels can damage decks and luggage cases such as these can also be difficult to stow on a yacht. Please pack your belongings into soft bags and allow a deckhand to porter them for you.

Tipping protocol

Leaving a gratuity is common practice on luxury charters. This ensures that crew who have gone the extra mile, while working far from home, consistently strive to offer exemplary service. The industry standard ranges from 10% and 20% of the charter fee, although a Moravia charter broker can advise if you are unsure. Gratuities are best left with the captain and they will ensure that those working hard below deck, including engineers and service staff, also share your goodwill.
